Familiarize yourself with the chemicals








Note the nearest exit, emergency eyewash, shower, and fire extinguisher

Wear appropriate protective gear







Place chemicals at least 6" inside the hood





Do not impede the airflow





Keep the sash open at 18" or less



After Using a Fume Hood

- Shut the sash
- Place hazardous materials in a closed container
